## SEDS-Canada and the Canadian Space Agency (CSA) select two teams for CAN-SBX 2020.

**Toronto, ON**: Students for the Exploration and Development of Space (SEDS-Canada) has selected two finalist teams for the 2020 <u>Canadian Stratospheric Balloon Experiment Design Challenge (CAN-SBX)</u>. CAN-SBX is a competition for Canadian post-secondary students to design and test a small scientific experiment to fly onboard an expandable balloon provided by the <u>Canadian Space Agency</u> (CSA).

For the previous two iterations of CAN-SBX, student teams designed and tested experiments for a CNES gondola, as part of the <u>STRATOS</u> partnership between the CSA and CNES. This year, the CAN-SBX Design Challenge will take advantage of the new CSA expandable balloon platform, allowing for payloads of up to 4 kg on their own small gondolas. CAN-SBX 2020 selected teams include:

• Western U Balloon Team (Western UBT) from the University of Western Ontario/Institute for Earth and Space Exploration is measuring the effects of ionizing radiation on organic compounds for future human-spaceflight considerations.

• **Team NEUDOSE-HAB** from **McMaster University** is testing a part of their cubesat NEUtron DOSimeter Experiment (NEUDOSE), which is part of the CSA's Canadian Cubesat Project. NEUDOSE is designed to be able to detect and measure high-energy charged and neutral particles in space.

Students will have the opportunity to attend the 2020 launch campaign which will directly involve students in launch operations, flight tracking, and payload recovery. The goal of CAN-SBX 2019-2020 is for students to gain enough experience from SBX 2020 to lead balloon launches from their home institutions.
