The CSC English-to-French Translator will be responsible for ensuring that Canadians of both official languages are able to stay informed about current events in Canada's space industry. The Translator will be tasked with interpreting English social media statements and writing them in French to better serve every citizen.

SEDS-Canada is seeking a passionate individual interested in joining the Social-Media team to build public awareness about our activities while adhering to a regular publishing schedule. The applicant should be fluent in English and French and possess a familiarity with social networking tools. Graphic editing is an asset but not required. Additionally, the individual should demonstrate strong communication skills along with a basic understanding of the SEDS-Canada mandate.

Primary duties:

- Work with the Canadian Space Conference team to translate English content into French
- Keeping audience engaged by responding to French commentary in a timely manner
- Translating text on graphics
- Translating for Conference documents

Requirements:

- Time: 4-5 hours/week
- Written example to exemplify French writing proficiency
- Excellent communication skills
- Self-motivated & independent
